Dear Family & Friends,

Adding to the difficult news we shared in the last update, we now are confirming that a nursing home Resident has also tested positive for Covid-19. This was verified with two additional follow up tests. Fortunately, the Resident is asymptomatic and the entire household where she resides has been on lock down since the employee first tested positive on July 27<sup>th</sup>.

Today, we learned the news that another employee on that same household has also tested positive. She was immediately sent home after being re-tested this morning. Once again she is not showing any symptoms and we are hopeful that these three cases will be the extent of the spread within our Home. There have been no other positive results reported to us.

All Residents in the affected household and in the neighboring household have been re-tested along with all staff on those units. We will share the results once they are reported to us, but there have been significant delays between test dates and results making this situation very challenging. We will continue to monitor Residents, screen staff and lock down households as needed.

Please continue to pray for our Home, Residents, Sisters and Staff.
